

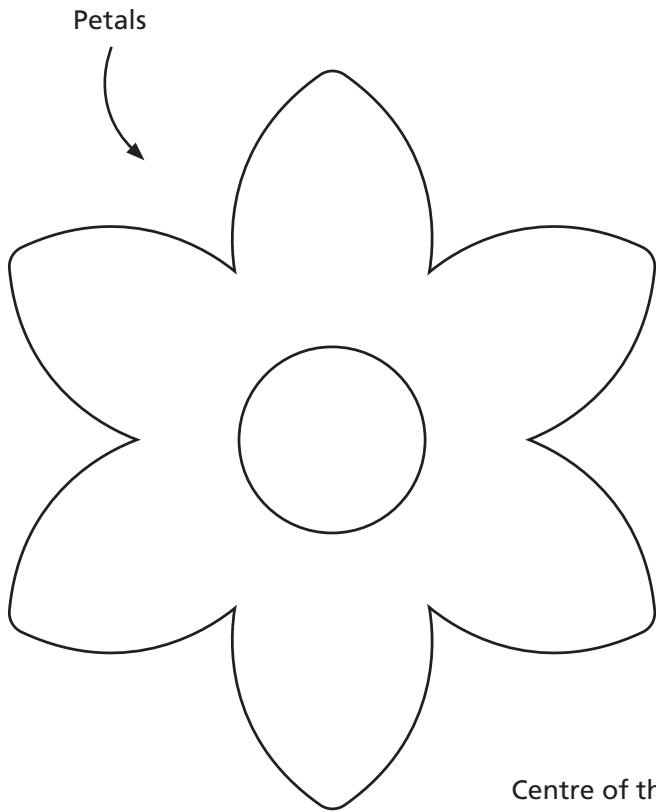
Daffodil Day Garland

Items needed:

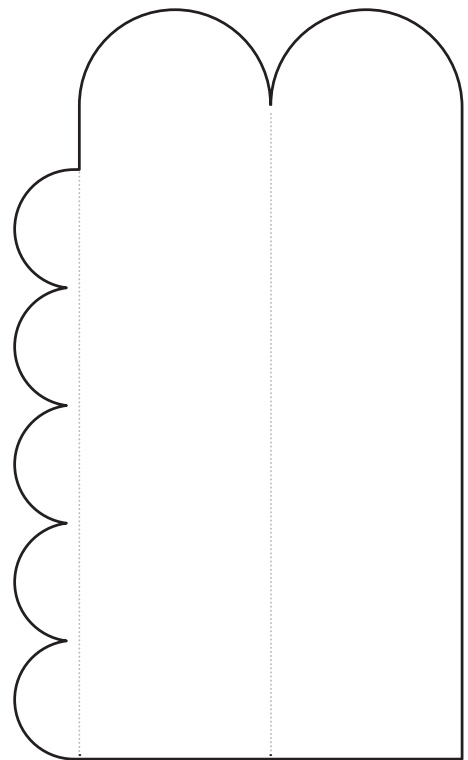
1. Glue stick
2. Scissors
3. Coloured pencils

Instructions:

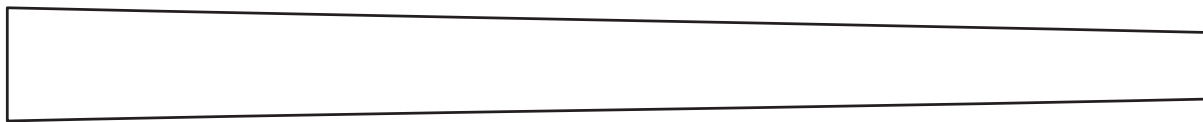
- 1** Colour the petals yellow and the centre orange. Don't forget to colour the stem green, that will be used to connect the daffodils to make the garland.
- 2** Cut out everything (make sure to ask an adult for help using scissors). Safety first!
- 3** Fold the centre of the daffodil on the dotted line so the part you coloured is facing out. Then roll up the centre to make a cylinder shape and glue the end together.

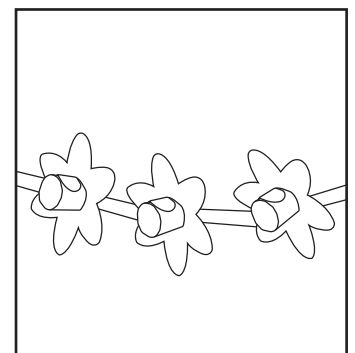
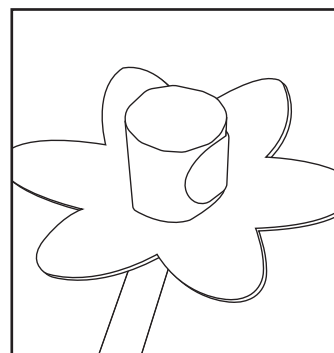
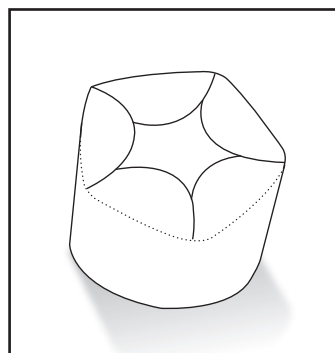
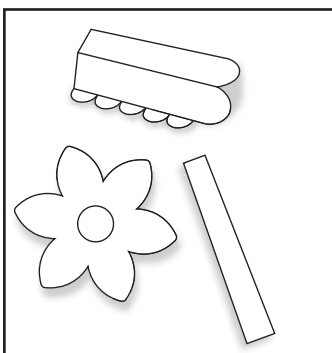
- 4** Fold the half circular tabs inwards on the bottom and use the tabs to glue to the middle of your yellow daffodil.



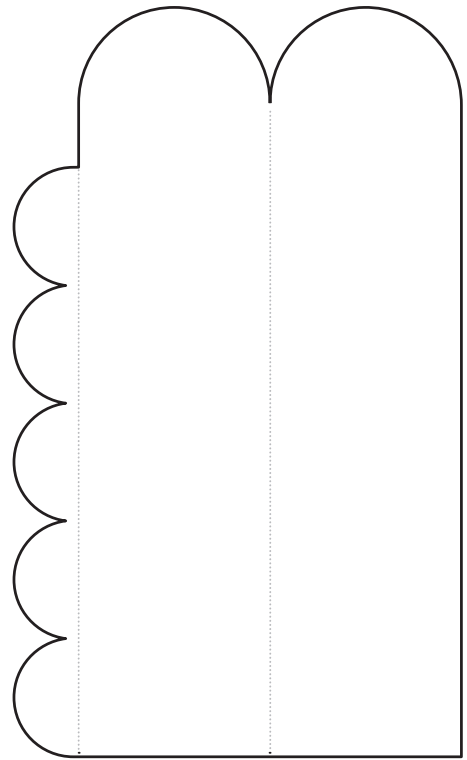
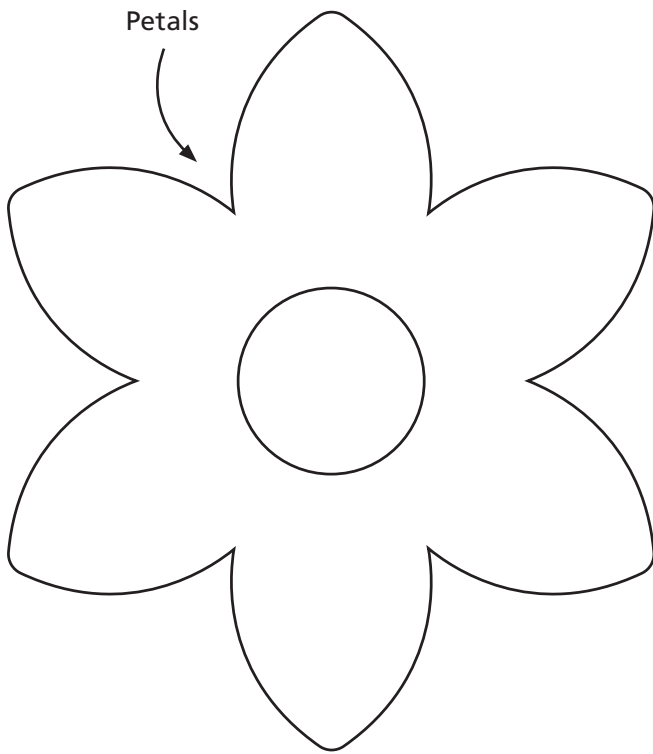
- 5** Put a little bit of glue on the end of the green stem and glue to the back of the daffodils to connect them to each other.

- 6** Ta da! You have created the daffodil garland.

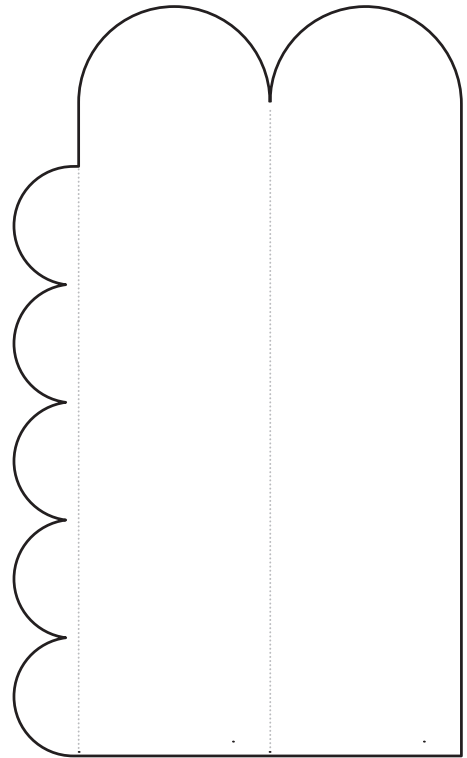
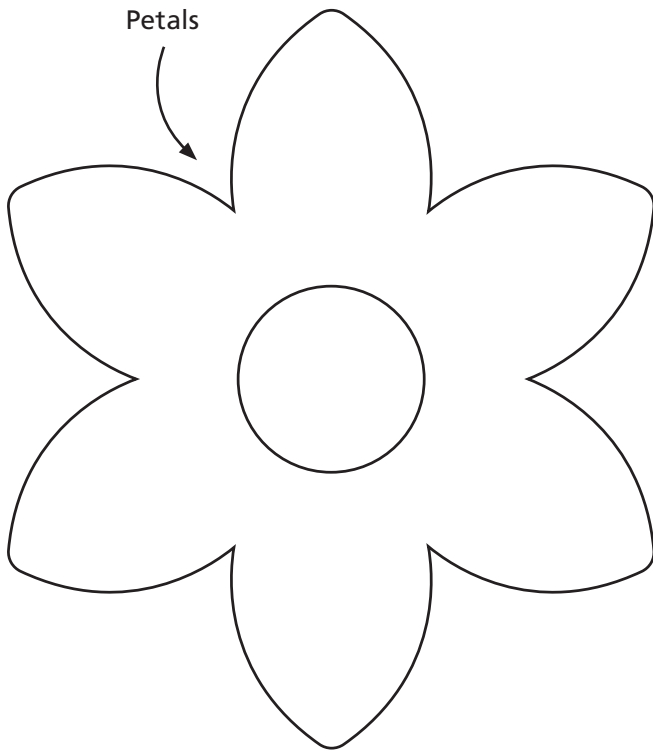
Stem
