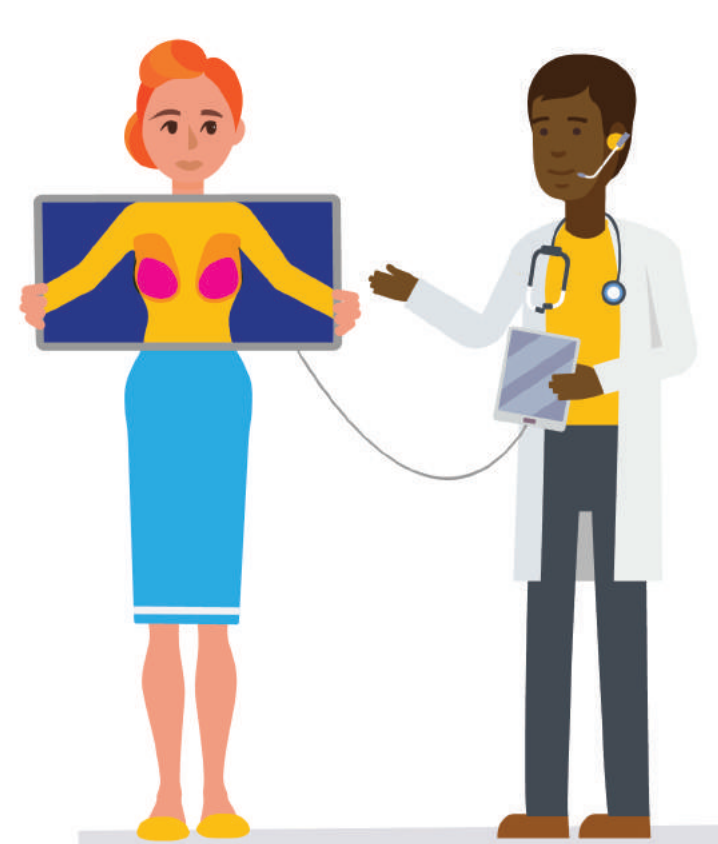
Research important?

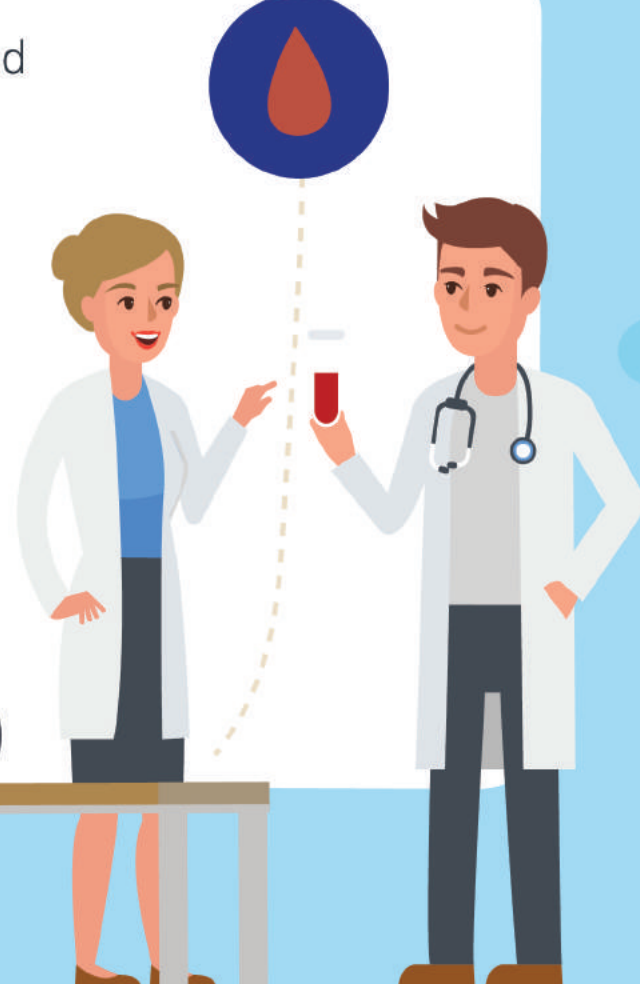
BREAST-PREDICT

BREAST-PREDICT is a country-wide collaboration among more than 50 breast cancer researchers. **Sharing skills and expertise**, BREAST-PREDICT collects information and tumour samples from breast cancer patients to help us better understand this disease and find ways to stop it. BREAST-PREDICT is funded solely by the Irish Cancer Society.



Blood Cancer Network Ireland

Blood Cancer Network Ireland (BCNI) **brings specialists together** to make novel drugs and treatments available to blood cancer patients across Ireland and collects information and samples to support future research. BCNI is jointly funded by the Irish Cancer Society and Science Foundation Ireland.

The Irish Prostate Cancer Outcomes Research (IPCOR) study looks at how prostate cancer patients' care can be improved and **treatment experiences made easier**. IPCOR is jointly funded by the Irish Cancer Society and the Movember Foundation.

Cancer Trials Ireland co-ordinates more than 100 clinical trials in hospitals across Ireland and Europe. These trials give participants early and free access to new and
