# STEP BY STEP GUIDE FOR YOUTH GROUPS ...

#### 1. APPLY...

- Read entry criteria & submit your application at www.cancer.ie/xhale, apply for a grant by March 5th if needed (groups can take part and get training/resources without grant)
- New X-HALE Youth Advocate and Gaisce opportunities are also open to your group

#### 2. LEARN...

- Your group members and youth workers can register for smoking prevention/film training and bring the skills and facts they pick up back to your group
- Do sessions from the X-HALE Training pack to learn about different smoking topics
- Use the X-HALE webpage, SpunOut.ie to and recommended websites for research

# 3. PLAN...

- Refer to the competition rules provided before you start planning your film
- Decide on your theme, film type( short, animation, stop motion, interview, documentary, music video, advert?) and the genre (action, comedy, drama, true story?)
- Decide on the age category of young people that your film is aimed at and think about what they would watch/share. ..your film could save their life!
- Storyboard and script your film with start middle and end using resources provided
- Decide roles; acting, directing, sound, lighting, props, makeup, editing and media
- Do a few rehearsals
- Send the link to any social media pages you plan to use to share pictures/vlogs/blogs to udelahunt@irishcancer.ie to be in with a chance of winning *Best Blogging Group!*

## 4. SHOOT...

- Organise shoot dates and locations
- Work with the equipment you have to maximise sound and picture quality
- Take different types of shots for variety (close up, mid shot, long shot)
- Film for 10 seconds before/after your shot ,use resources provided to help you edit
- Share pics/videos/blog pieces about what your doing/learning with #xhale2020 to be in with a chance of winning *Best Blogging Group*!
- Keep an eye out for additional opportunities for your group members that will be advertised through out the competition!

# 5. EDIT...

- Download free Movie Maker software for PC's or iMovie for MACs or register for a free Adobe Premier Pro trial and use www.incompetech.com for copyright free music
- Use training resources provided to help you
- Your film MUST be under 2:30 including credits and be copyright free to be accepted

#### 6. SUBMIT...

• Submit your film to udelahunt@irishcancer.ie by the May 21st 2020deadline using the guide to www.wetransfer.com provided.

#### 7. SHARE...

- Maximise the reach & impact of your film by getting as many young people as possible to watch & share it from the X-HALE 2020 playlist during your *Online & Community Campaign* from May 28th–July 2nd..your film could save lives!
- Share your film using #xhale2020 on social media
- Print out our customisable online competition poster, ask if you can stick it up in your centre, in local primary schools & in shops around your town
- The film with the most views by July 2nd will win the Online Competition Award
- Use the customisable screening poster to advertise a screening of your film for group members, friends & family or ask about showing it in local primary schools
- Download our customisable press release & send it into your local paper
- Share pictures/video clips to show what you are doing for your community campaign, tag @IrishCancerSoc on Twitter, @irishcancersociety on Instagram & @XHaleYouthAwards on Facebook to win the *Community Campaign Award*!
