Illness benefit for COVID-19



If you are an employee or are self-employed and cannot work due to COVID-19, you can apply for an Illness Benefit Payment of €350 per week.

Do I qualify?

You must be self-isolating on the instruction of a doctor or medical professional

OR

Have been diagnosed with COVID-19

AND

- Must be confined to home / medical facility
- Must be absent from work and not getting paid

You may apply for an Illness Benefit Payment



How to apply

Contact your doctor by telephone.

If the doctor is satisfied that you have COVID-19 or that you should self-isolate, they will advise you accordingly.

The doctor will then complete a medical certificate and send it directly to the Department of Employment Affairs and Social Protection.

Your doctor will need your:

- Name
- PPS Number
- Date of Birth

Remain in contact with your doctor about the length of time you are medically certified unfit for work because of COVID-19.
