## How to make the most of your Big Pink Breakfast!

Below are some guidelines to help you with your fundraising.

#### **Start early**

The earlier you begin planning, the more people you can reach and the easier your fundraising will be.

## **Online fundraising**

When you registered you will have received your own JustGiving page. Make sure to activate your page (see your emails for details) and share with your family, friends and colleagues. It's a great way for them to be able to support and help you raise even more funds.

#### **QR** codes

Did you know that your JustGiving page comes with its own QR code? Simply add "/qrcode" to the end of your page link to find yours. You can print it out and have it at your event. This way you can take both cash and online donations!

Whenever someone donates, take a moment to thank them. Send a quick email or share a status update on social media to thank each person who contributes to your page.

## How to get the word out

## Spread the word

Tell your friends, family and colleagues that you're raising money to fund support services and life-changing research for breast cancer patients and their families. Send a text or share a link to your fundraising page via email, WhatsApp, or Messenger. And if you're hosting your event at the office, don't forget to share the link through your workplace's internal communications tools.

## Alert the press

Send your story into local newspapers. Include all your fundraising information and why you are getting involved this October.

## Pop it on your socials

The fastest way to promote your fundraiser is through social media.

## How to check your breasts

Get to know what's normal for you by checking once a month.



## **Look for changes**

Stand in front of a mirror. With your arms by your side:



Dimpling or puckering to your skin.



Discharge (liquid) from one or both of your nipples.



A pulled-in, sunken or flattened nipple.



A rash, flaky or crusted skin on or around the nipple.



Look for changes to the shape or size of your breasts and/or nipples.



Now do the same with your hands on your hips, tilting slightly forward.



## **Feel for changes**

This may be easiest to do in the shower using a warm soapy hand. If you have larger breasts, it may be easier to do lying down.



Using the flat part of your middle 3 fingers, start from the nipple and move clockwise until you have covered the whole breast, armpit and collarbone. Feel for:



Repeat on the other side.



Lumps, thickening or changes.



Swelling



A breast abscess (infected boil).

9 out of 10 breast changes are not cancer. But if you spot a change, talk to your GP without delay.

## How your support helps

## Supporting breast cancer patients in 2023:

- Fuelled more than 4,630 lifts to treatment for over 485 breast cancer patients through the Irish Cancer Society's Transport Service.
- The Irish Cancer Society's Support Line and Daffodil Day Centre nurses supported people affected by breast cancer through over 5,490 supportive and comforting conversations
- More than 430 nights of vital end of life comfort and care to breast cancer patients through the Irish Cancer Society's Night Nursing Service.
- Provide over 4,825 free counselling sessions to help breast cancer patients cope with their diagnosis.

How your donations will fund support for breast cancer patients:



€30 can help provide transport for a breast cancer patient to and from their chemotherapy treatment using the Irish Cancer Society's Transport Service.



€50 can help provide vital clinical equipment for an Irish Cancer Society Night Nurse.



€60 will cover the cost of a counselling session to help a person cope with a breast cancer diagnosis in their life.



€430 will cover the cost of one night of Night Nursing, providing end of life care to a breast cancer patient in their own home.

## **Donating your funds**

Please bank your donations within 4 weeks of your event so your hard-earned funds can start supporting people straight away.

## **JustGiving/Online Fundraising pages**

If you are raising funds on JustGiving or another online fundraising page, the donations are automatically transferred to us monthly, so you don't have to worry about lodging your funds.
