


Less than half of the Irish public know that lung cancer is the number one cause of cancer death in Ireland PROPERTY OF THE PROPERTY OF TH

## **LUNG HEALTH**



Half of all adults are unconcerned about lung cancer and 35% of adults with three or more symptoms of lung cancer are also unconcerned

Almost a quarter of adults (22%) would be afraid to go to their doctor with symptoms of lung cancer


